THE CHILD ADVOCACY CENTER

The Child Advocacy Center of Northeast Missouri serves child victims of sexual and physical abuse in 14 counties including Warren, St. Charles and Lincoln. Since opening our doors in 2000, our staff and community partners have been the front-line responders to reports of child abuse. Our organization exists to protect children, heal families and prevent abuse. Unfortunately, this past year we have witnessed an unprecedented number of child abuse cases, a 25% increase over last year.

During this special season of giving, The Child Advocacy Center gratefully acknowledges everyone who has been a part of our work this year through volunteering, attending fundraisers, spreading the word about the work we do, and giving financial resources to continue the important mission of assisting children and families in crisis. Because of our community's support, we are able to provide over 1,200 abused children a safe place to disclose of abuse with our forensic interviews, child and family advocacy to the families, mental health therapy for as long as they need to heal, and school and community-based prevention education programs to create awareness and keep kids safe – ***all at no cost to the family or community.***

The Child Advocacy Center is eligible for the **Champion for Children Tax Credit**. That means donations of \$100 or more by an individual or business may qualify you to receive 50% tax credit on your donation, which comes right off your Missouri state income tax liability. 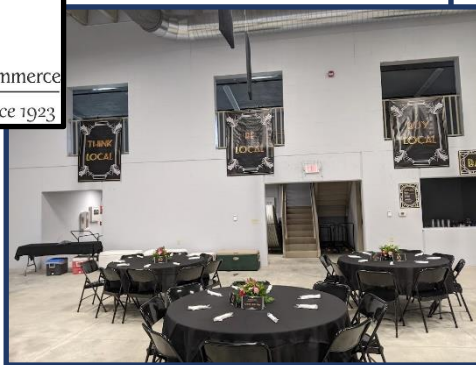

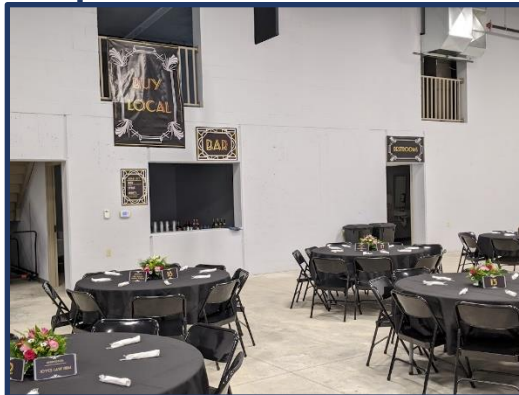

Why attend the CPA?

CPA graduates typically return to their communities as better-informed citizens, capable of using their newly acquired information to help improve the conditions and quality of life in their community

Eligibility:

People from all walks of life are eligible to attend the Academy, including concerned citizens, Neighborhood Association members, Civic Organization members, college students, potential police applicants, factory workers, independent business people, city and county workers, Neighborhood Watch member, and many others.

Requirements

- Persons interested in attending a Citizen Police Academy must live, work, or attend school within Warren County.
- Persons must be at least 18 years of age, have no prior felony convictions, have not been a suspect in a crime involving moral turpitude, have no involvement in criminal behavior or have police contact believed to compromise the integrity of the Citizen Police Academy or the Warrenton Police Department and have no outstanding warrants.
- The Warrenton Police Department reserves the right to disqualify any applicant as a result of information discovered during the background investigation.
- Applicants must provide two personal references.
- Past participants are allowed to attend future classes; however, preference will be given to first time participants if the class exceeds 20 participants.
