Innsbrook to Host Treehouse Tour and Open House on October 22

INNSBROOK, MO (October 10, 2022) - Experience the serene beauty of a Midwestern fall as you tour Innsbrook's newest development, the Treehouses of Talblich, located in the Tyrolean region of Innsbrook. Innsbrook is a recreational lake community less than an hour west of St. Louis. Members of the public are invited to attend an open house tour of various treehouse properties and nearby amenities on Saturday, October 22. Open house tours begin at noon and end at 4:00 p.m.

Innsbrook's treehouse concept blurs the lines between stylish contemporary home design and your childhood hideaway floating high above the forest floor. The first community of its kind is made up of 34 wooded lots from phase I and phase II of development, with an additional 23 lots in phase III set to open soon. Treehouse lot sizes range from 1.3 to 2.3 acres and feature dramatic elevation changes with stunning views. Treehouses are offered in one, two, and three bedroom models, with the choice of gable or shed rooflines and optional upgrades.

Visitors will have the opportunity to view multiple treehouse properties showcasing the three bedroom, two bathroom model. Our completed display model, as well as two neighboring lots, currently in various stages of construction, will be open for viewing. Each treehouse on the tour is constructed on piers with a shed roofline and display a variety of upgrade options. Those interested can explore the phase III treehouse lots that will be opening soon.

Before heading out to explore the community, enjoy complimentary beer, brats, and hot dogs at the new pool and pavilion, located in the Tyrol area near the treehouse community.

Pre-registration is recommended, but not required. The tour is self-guided and will take place at 2805 Tyrol Ridge Drive, Innsbrook, MO 63390. STEP 2
 50% of the pledge is due immediately. The remainder can be paid at an agreed upon date.

STEP 3
 You will receive a tax credit form to complete. You send that back to AGAPE and we submit it to the State. We will return the tax certificate to you.

FAQ's

Is there a minimum amount I can buy?
 No, you can purchase any amount.

How long do the tax credits last for?
 You can carry over the tax credits for five years.

What do the tax credits go to fund?
 The tax credits fund our 2 job training programs. Job STAR is our job training for adults and SPARK is our job training program for youth.

Will tax credits be available next year?
 No, these are 2 year programs, so it is important to pledge the entire amount you would want for this year and next year all at this time.

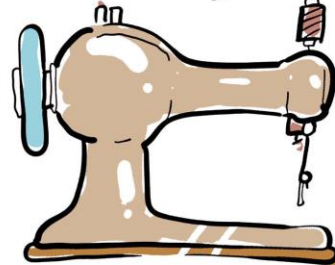

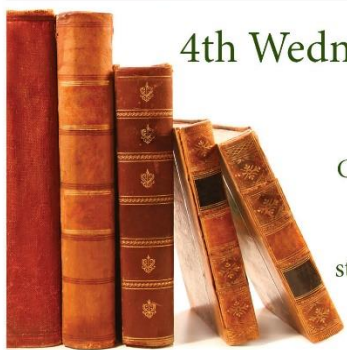
