**Business Spotlight  
Warren County Ambulance District**



Time flies by fast and although we may want things to slow down just a bit to catch our breath, there really isn't time for that when we live in a community on the fast track of growth! We will all blink our eyes and find ourselves five years down the road and things will look much different in Warren County.

Planning is essential and the team here at Warren County Ambulance District is in the thick of it. The district's 10-year updated strategic plan will guide the Board of Directors and administration to prepare for the expected new growth while combating a 15% increase in calls over the past 23 months and surpassed 4,000 calls already this year.

The district currently employs 47 people on the payroll with tenures ranging from 28 years to less than six months. We are proud to have them all on the team and part of this community. As with every employer in the country, the commitment to retain and recruit quality employees is key to an organization's success and we feel this is the reason for consistent quality emergency medical services in Warren County, that generations have deserved since the inception of the district in 1974.

We are committed to embracing the eminent growth, expanding the areas of the district required to support the growth and continue to grow the team here at Warren County Ambulance District for the community to be proud of for years to come.

Missouri Chamber Federation Legislative Priorities 2023

- 1) We support a broad-spectrum approach to upskilling and right-skilling our state's workforce to address labor shortages and help businesses' growth. This includes adequately funding our existing workforce development programs, like Fast Track and Missouri One Start job training, and advocating for new policies that are responsive and flexible to businesses' needs to recruit and retain skilled workers today while anticipating employment needs of the future.
- 2) Small businesses are the backbone of our economy. Therefore, Missouri should increase access to funding and other resources for small businesses, start-ups, and entrepreneurs to help them confidently start, grow, or expand.
- 3) Childcare is a pivotal workforce development issue. Working parents' re-entry into the workforce can be hindered by childcare provider shortages for children of all ages, but especially for those under two years old. Missouri should increase the accessibility and availability of high quality childcare for working parents.
- 4) Economic development drives growth, creates new job opportunities and facilitates an improved quality of life. Missouri should embrace an all-of-the-above approach in utilizing and offering innovative economic development tools and tax incentives to help its local communities and businesses thrive.
- 5) Public transportation is both a workforce and economic development tool in our communities statewide. We must adequately fund multi-modal public transit systems so they are more accessible and efficient for residents and visitors alike.
- 6) A safer Missouri is a stronger Missouri. The state should dedicate adequate funding for public safety. This includes funding for the expansion of mental health and substance abuse treatment and prevention programs, public safety staffing enhancement efforts, and innovative tools to reduce crime.
- 7) A strong education system is key to Missouri's long-term economic health and competitiveness. We support efforts to adequately fund all levels of education, from elementary to higher education. Additionally, we should increase funding and

accessibility of student scholarship programs, like the A+ program.

- 8) The state has a detrimental reputation for its unfair legal climate. Therefore, Missouri must implement significant reforms to ensure our legal climate is not an impediment to economic competitiveness. We support a wide variety of reforms, including modifying the statute of limitations, to bring more fairness to our court system.
- 9) We support comprehensive efforts to maximize Missouri's position as an emerging technology hub. By enacting innovative policies, increasing investment, and training our workforce for high-tech jobs, our state can grow its global tech and innovation footprint.
- 10) State investment in tourism supports economic growth, job creation, and tax revenue. We support increasing funding of tourism promotion and other tourism-related programs, as it would positively impact many communities across the state.
- 11) The state has a once-in-a-generation opportunity to make significant investments due to a very positive ongoing budgetary outlook. We encourage Missouri's leaders to utilize these funding opportunities to make investments that have a transformational impact on communities statewide. Conversely, we oppose efforts to risk vital funding streams needed for our state's infrastructure. The state's economic growth depends on having reliable and modern infrastructure systems, which includes our vast network of roads and bridges.
- 12) We strongly support a system of free enterprise and oppose efforts by the government to intervene in business decisions. The government should let business decide how to run its own workplace(s).

### 50% YOP Credits

YOP tax credits are 50% credits and are available to any individual in Missouri.

**Step 2**  
50% of the pledge is due immediately. The remainder can be paid at an agreed upon date.

**Step 3**  
You will receive a tax credit form to complete. You send that back to AGAPE and we submit it to the State. We will return the tax certificate to you.

### FAQ's

**Is there a minimum amount I can buy?**  
No, you can purchase any amount.

**How long do the tax credits last for?**  
You can carry over the tax credits for five years.

**What do the tax credits go to fund?**  
The tax credits fund our 2 job training programs. Job STAR is our job training for adults and SPARK is our job training program for youth.

**Will tax credits be available next year?**  
No, these are 2 year programs, so it is important to pledge the entire amount you would want for this year and next year all at this time.

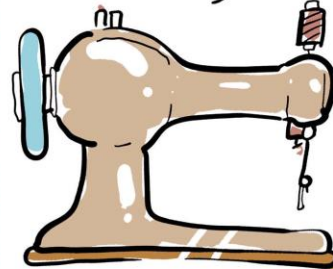

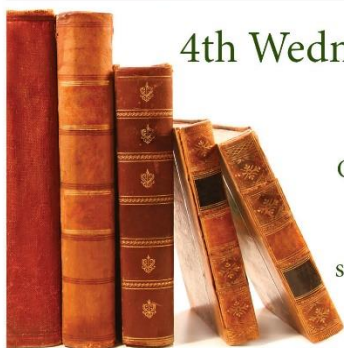

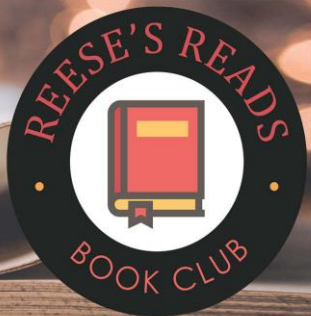
