# LAP LANE RESERVATIONS

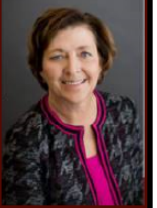
New Year resolutions create a high demand for lap lane exercise. To best meet the needs of our patrons, we are introducing Lap Lane Reservations.
