5 TOP SKILLS FOR EFFECTIVE LEADERSHIP

1.Communication skills

Having integrity as a leader not only encourages best practices and results but also sends your team a strong and positive example

5. Delegation

Leaders who try to take on too many tasks by themselves will struggle to get anything done. These leaders often fear that it's a sign of weakness to delegate tasks rather they are a sign of a strong leader. You need to identify each individual employee's skills and assign each employee's responsibilities based on his skills. You can focus on other important tasks by delegating tasks to employees.
